Detailed justification by the mid-term assessment Committee regarding the result of the mid-term evaluation:

The doctoral thesis focuses on the functional *in vitro* analysis of selected genetic variants of LDLR gene. According to the Committee's assessment, the execution of the research plan has been progressing smoothly. Based on the Doctoral Student's presentation and the report, the Committee has determined that the Doctoral Student has made excellent progress in doctoral work. Furthermore, the Doctoral Student was able to effectively address all questions and

comments posed by the Committee Members during the evaluation process. The plan for the next stages of the project does not raise any concerns, and no factors dependent on the PhD student have been identified that could negatively affect their implementation.
