The title of the doctoral dissertation project of PhD student Agnieszka Skrzypkowska is "Clinimetric properties of protocol for the assessment of right hemispheric dysfunctions for use in clinical practice and research"

The aim oft he project is to create a protocol assessing deficits related to right hemisphere lesions that can be used along NIHSS. The doctoral student conducts the validation and evaluation of clinical usefullness of each subtest in acute phase of stroke and comparison of right hemispheric stroke volumes in CT along with their NIHSS scores adjusted with scores from protocol with left hemispheric stroke volumes .

PhD student Agnieszka Skrzypkowska reported the problem of employment at UCK, and thus the recruitment of patients, but this problem was positively resolved.

The tasks completed so far are fully aligned with the objectives outlined in the IPB. The PhD student correctly approaches the analysis and interpretation of results (validation tests), which contributes to the theoretical and practical foundations of the research she conducts.
