Mid-term assessment Committee comments:

The Committee had the possibility to listen to presentation of the Student. The presentation was given in a proper scientific style with legible visualisation of the progress of the doctoral project and of development of the Student. Professor Małgorzata Szczuko asked additional questions about the planned size of the examined and controlled group. Professor Tomasz Śledziński asked about additional details of planned original paper and about the general structure of the thesis. Professor Mariusz Siemiński asked the Student about possibilities of implementation of the studied method in everyday clinical practice. All the members of the Committee received satisfying responses. During the closed meeting of the Committee professor Małgorzata Szczuko pointed at high quality of the presentation and on very advanced phase of realization of the project with high number of recruited participants, first published paper and documented presentations of the results at multiple scientific events. Professor Tomasz Śledziński pointed at minor delays in the realization of the tasks within the projects but all the members of the Committee agreed that those delays do not threaten realization of the doctoral project.
