Both reviewers participating in the periodic assessment drew attention to the risk of collecting the appropriate, planned number of patients and the need to change the statistical assumptions related to this. Nevertheless, the committee unanimously accepted and adopted the report, recognizing its further continuation.

Detailed justification by the mid-term assessment Committee regarding the result of the mid-term evaluation:

The presented results of previous work were featured smoothly without any mistakes. According to the Committee's assessment, the execution of the research plan has been progressing in proper way. Based on the heard and seen presentation, done by the Student, and the report, the Committee has determined that the doctoral student has made adequate progress in doctoral work. The Student was able to address effectively all questions and comments posted by the Committee Members during the evaluation process. Presented plan for the next stages of the project does not rise any concerns and no factors dependent on the doctorate process have been identified that could negatively affect their implementation. The publication plan sounds reasonable and has the potential to be achieve. The only concern is regarding to careful attention to the study design and sample size should be taken to ensure the validity and applicability of the findings. The Committee members based on the presentation they listened to and the questions asked, do not see any danger in further work on the project and its positive conclusion with appropriate publications.
